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Overview

Methodology

The National Iranian American Council (NIAC) commissioned Zogby Analytics to conduct a mixed-mode online and live-operator telephone survey of 508 Iranian-Americans between March 24-27, 2026.

Using internal and trusted interactive partner resources, thousands of adults were randomly invited from sourced panels to participate in this online survey. Each invitation is password coded and secure so that one respondent can only access the survey one time.

Using information based on census data, voter registration figures, CIA fact books and exit polls, we use complex weighting techniques to best represent the demographics of the population being surveyed. Weighted variables may include age, race, gender, region, party, education, and religion.

Based on a confidence interval of 95%, the margin of error for 508 is +/- 4.4 percentage points. This means that all other things being equal, the identical survey repeated will have results within the margin of error 95 times out of 100.


This survey was conducted as a follow-up to a previous NIAC-commissioned poll by Zogby Analytics of 505 Iranian Americans fielded between February 27–March 5, 2026, allowing for comparison of community views as the war unfolded.

US-Iran War

Views on US-Iran War

1. What is your position regarding the United States war on Iran?

A significant majority of Iranian Americans oppose the United States war on Iran, with 66.1% opposed (48.4% strongly, 17.7% somewhat) and 32.7% in support (18.6% strongly, 14.1% somewhat), while 1.2% prefer not to answer.




Iranian American opinion has shifted dramatically against the war since our previous poll, conducted February 27-March 5, in which respondents were evenly divided (49.3% oppose vs. 48.9% support). This represents a 16.8 percentage point increase in opposition to the war and a 16.2 percentage points decrease in support.

Views Opposing War

1B. FOR RESPONDENTS WHO OPPOSE THE U.S. WAR ON IRAN ONLY


What best describes why you oppose the United States war on Iran? [select up to two]

The 66.1% of respondents who oppose the U.S. war on Iran were asked to choose up to two reasons for their opposition. The most common choice was war is killing and injuring innocent civilians (61.2%), followed by war is destabilizing the country and leading to more violence (43.6%), worsening the human rights situation (36.1%), and that it is unprovoked and illegal under international law (31.2%). A smaller share (15.7%) indicated that war will entrench the Iranian government and strengthen hardliners.

1C. FOR RESPONDENTS WHO SUPPORT THE U.S. WAR ON IRAN ONLY


What best describes why you support the United States war on Iran? [select up to two]

The 32.7% of respondents who support the U.S. war on Iran were asked to choose up to two reasons for their support. The most common choice was that war would undermine the Iranian government and make regime change more likely (67.3%). Other top reasons include improving the human rights situation (56%), reducing threats posed by Iran’s nuclear and missile programs (47%), and enforcing U.S. red lines (16.9%).


Views on the Continuation of the Current War

2. Should the U.S. continue the war or end it?

A significant majority of 70.7% of Iranian Americans believe the United States should end the war, compared to 25.6% who believe it should continue, and 3.7% who prefer not to answer.

Views on U.S. Ground Troops

3. What is your position regarding the United States potentially sending ground troops into Iran?


Iranian Americans overwhelmingly oppose the deployment of U.S. ground troops into Iran, with 69.4% opposing (48.3% strongly, 21.1% somewhat) compared to 30.1% who support such action (12.7% strongly, 17.4% somewhat), while 0.5% prefer not to answer.

■ Strongly ■ Somewhat ■ Prefer Not to Answer



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

Views on Diplomacy

4. What is your position regarding the United States negotiating an agreement with Iran to end the war?

A significant majority of Iranian Americans support negotiating an agreement to end the war, with 64.3% in favor (38.5% strongly, 25.8% somewhat) compared to 35% who oppose diplomacy (21.8% strongly, 13.2% somewhat), while less than 1% prefer not to answer.

Support for the Iranian People


5. What do you think is the best U.S. approach to support the Iranian people? [Select up to two]

When asked to select up to two options, Iranian Americans most commonly chose ending the war (47.9%) as the best way to support the Iranian people. Other top responses were pursuing regime change (31.2%), urging Iran to improve its human rights record (21.6%), lifting sanctions (18.9%), and countering internet blackouts (17%). Smaller shares support continuing the war (13.5%) or increasing sanctions (10.2%), while 12.2% say the U.S. should not pursue this goal.

Daily Life for Ordinary Iranians

6A. What do you think the outcomes of this war will be one year from now?


Daily life for ordinary Iranians

A majority of Iranian Americans believe the war will worsen daily life for ordinary Iranians, with 57.3% expecting conditions to deteriorate compared to 33.2% who believe life will improve and 7.5% who expect no effect.

What do you think the outcomes of this war will be one year from now in regard to the daily life for ordinary Iranians?



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

Regime Survival

6B. What do you think the outcomes of this war will be one year from now?

Regime survival

A majority of Iranian Americans believe the Islamic Republic will remain in power one year from now (53.3%), with 37.4% saying the Islamic Republic will remain in power and be weaker and 15.9% saying it will remain in power and be stronger. A significant percentage of respondents (8.6%) said they preferred not to answer. 38.1% believe the government will be removed from power.

Views on Post-Islamic Republic Regime


7. If the war removes the Islamic Republic from power, what is the most likely outcome?

If the war leads to the removal of the Islamic Republic, 37.1% of Iranian Americans believe a better government will take power while 60.4% anticipate negative outcomes, including state collapse (28.4%), a worse government taking power (18.6%), or civil war (13.4%).

Views on Regime Change


8. What is your view regarding regime change in Iran?

A significant majority of Iranian Americans want to see Iran's government changed but only by the Iranian people, not foreign intervention (61.1%) 27.5% say the U.S. should seek to change Iran's government by any means necessary, including military intervention. 9.9% oppose a change of Iran's government.
